Dear church family,

This past week was a very special time for my family. Saturday, January 23, we celebrate the one year mark of the arrival of our baby girl. I will be the very first to admit to you, this past year has been trying, but I would not change one minute. When I think back over the memories, tears come to my eyes. Many of you know our story and you stood beside my family as we walked into unknown territory. I am quickly reminded of how love can change a person. That Friday as we eagerly awaited a call to receive a little girl (which we knew nothing about), many questions came to mind.

I laugh as I think of the one question April asked me, "Devin what if she is ugly?" As they ushered this little baby girl through an office door, I noticed a few things. First, she was frightened and her lip was poked out. Secondly, her face was extremely dirty along with her clothes that were also way to big for her. And finally, it was obvious, that she just need to be loved. I stand amazed of how when you love someone with no hidden motives and you love them with the very core of your soul, how that love changes everything, even their external and internal appearance. Brooklyn's appearance and personality



changed.

I quickly think of a passage when I look back at our journey and relationship with our daughter...*But God is so rich in mercy, and he loved us so much, that even though we were dead because of our sins, he gave us life when he raised Christ from the dead. (It is only by God's grace that you have been saved!)*...Eph 2:4-5, NLT. When they brought her to me and I held her for the very first time, all those questions seemed to not even matter. For it is by grace that we are saved!!
